The California Department of Boating and Waterways publishes the following free materials which provide information on boating rules, safety and recreational facilities. Single copies or quantities of the publications listed below can be ordered from the Department using the attached order form. (Organizations and individuals outside California are limited to five copies of each publication.)

ABCs Of The California Boating Law - Explains state boating laws and regulations for equipment, registration, rules of the road, vessel operation, accident reporting, and aids to navigation. Includes an accident report form and float plan.

AquaSMART Activity Book For Kids - 24-page coloring-and-activities book on water and boating safety (*in English or Spanish.*)

Basic Safety Rules For Boating - Displays the rules of the road on a peel-off sticker.

Boater Alert: Hydrilla - Explains what hydrilla is and tells boaters how they can avoid spreading this aquatic pest from one waterway to another.

Boating Films, Videos, Slide And Sound Catalog - Lists audio-visual presentations loaned at no charge to groups and individuals interested in boating safety.

Boating Safety Card - Illustrates the rules of the road, the California Waterway Marking System, weather advisories, and recognized distress signals on a 5" x 8 1/2" card.

A Boating Trail Guide To The American River Parkway - Includes safety hints and a map for paddling the lower American River (*Nimbus Dam to Sacramento River*).

A Boating Trail Guide To The Colorado River - Features 11 maps of the Colorado River, from Blythe to Imperial Dam.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Colorado River - Features 5 maps of the Colorado River, from Davis Dam to Parker Dam.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Kern River - Includes a map of the river and information on safety, logistics, camping and more.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Merced River - Features a map of the Merced River Canyon. Includes information on the history, wildlife, and fishing and fire regulations of the area.

A Boating Trail Guide To The North and Middle Forks Of The American River - Covers the North Fork from Iowa Hill Bridge to Lake Clementine and the Middle Fork from Oxbow Put-In to Mammoth Bar. Includes a map and a white water class system chart.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Sacramento River - Covers Redding to Red Bluff; includes a map, and information on the history and wildlife of the area.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Sacramento River - Covers Woodson Bridge to Colusa. Includes map access sites and a chart of float times.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Smith River - Features a map and information on safety, and the history and wildlife of this Wild and Scenic river.

A Boating Trail Guide To The South Fork of the American River - Features a public access map of the South Fork. Includes information on the history, plant life, and local regulations of the area.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Smith River - Covers all the navigable waters of this Wild and Scenic river to the ocean.

A Boating Trail Guide To The Tuolumne River - Covers the Tuolumne River from Don Pedro Dam to Yosemite National Park.

BUI Information Card - Lists penalties for boating under the influence.

California Boating Safety Course - A 60-page workbook you can study at home at your own pace. Covers state and federal laws, rules of the road, and much more. Take the optional 50-question test and send it to us for your official certificate of completion.

Chart Agents List - Lists agents authorized to sell nautical charts and related National Ocean Survey publications. (*Limit: 1 per order.*)

Clean Boating Habits - A guide to information and practices boaters can use to help protect California's waterways from pollution. Also includes info on foul weather preparation and required safety equipment.

A Consumer's Guide to Boating Lake Tahoe - The pamphlet answers boaters' questions regarding new Tahoe Regional Planning Agency regulations, including restrictions on the use of carbureted two-stroke engines on Tahoe Region lakes. Also provides information on how to minimize the environmental impacts of boating.

Drowning Prevention Checklist - Offers pool and spa owners a checklist of pointers to help prevent child drownings.

Facts About Boating And Alcohol - Explains effects of alcohol on boaters. Includes an alcohol consumption and blood-alcohol chart.

Facts About Boating Safety Classes - Gives the who, what, where, when, why, and how of boating safety classes.

Facts About Marine Pollution Laws - Covers state and federal laws governing the disposal of plastic debris and other garbage in the ocean, marine sanitation and the use of anti-fouling paint.

How to Buy a Used Boat - A consumer protection guide produced with the California Yacht Brokers Assn., it covers how to decide which boat is right for you; getting a loan and insurance; getting a sea trial and survey; sales agreements and contracts; and financial considerations.

Marine Security - Provides tips on what you can do to protect your boat and gear from theft.

Quiet Boating For Everyone - Provides information on the state's motorboat noise laws, and how to be a quiet boater.

Rescue Breathing Card - Lists on a wallet-sized card the steps in administering mouth-to-mouth resuscitation.

Safe Boating Hints For Lakes and Reservoirs - Covers the special conditions and problems of boating on lakes and reservoirs.

Safe Boating Hints For Fire Extinguishers - Describes the various types of Coast Guard-approved extinguishers for motor boats and the laws regarding them.

Safe Boating Hints For Hunters And Fishermen - Recommends safety precautions for people who use small boats to hunt and fish.

Safe Boating Hints On Paddle Craft - Explains the required equipment and recommended safety practices for using canoes, kayaks and inflatable rafts.

Safe Boating Hints On Personal Flotation Devices - Describes the various types of lifesaving devices and explains the number and types of devices required to be carried aboard.

Safe Boating Hints For Personal Watercraft - Contains information on boating safety classes, required and recommended equipment, the rules of the road, registration, and restrictions on speed, noise and age.

Vessel Pumpout Locator Cards - Maps show the location of vessel sewage pumpout facilities and dump stations for the following areas: North Coast - Inland; Sacramento San-Joaquin Delta; San Francisco Bay Area; and Monterey - SLO - Santa Barbara.
