The Sediment Master Plan is being prepared by the State of California Resources Agency and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The Sediment Master Plan focuses on developing an implementation strategy for integrated, region-wide solutions to sediment management problems. Examples of the issues to be addressed by the Sediment Master Plan are beach erosion and excess sedimentation in coastal wetlands and harbors.
