❖ **Updates: Federal Agencies**

Army Corps, LA District (Susie Ming)

- Malibu Creek – had a meeting last month to identify how to beneficially move sediment
 - Syd had a call with USACE Geologist yesterday to discuss sediment issues and beneficial reuse of material. Would like to have CSMW input/discussion on study.
- Solana Beach and Encinitas Shoreline study
 - Draft document expected to be completed by this summer for public review.
 - Rec'd \$300K in FY12 Work Plan
- CA Sediment Master Plan
 - Rec'd \$861K in FY12 Work Plan
 - NMBay RSM will be a priority in FY12
- FY12 Dredging
 - MDR Entrance Area – much of MDR material not suitable for beach placement. Port of LB will be disposal location. Dredging start date March 9.

Comment: Grain Size or contaminant issue?

Response: Contaminants issue

Comment: LA County will pay incremental cost of \$5.3 M to move material.

Comment: How much material from MDR going to Redondo?

Response: 160K CY

- Morro Bay
 - Yaquina placing all material downcoast – schedule June timeframe.
- Newport Harbor
 - Grain Size issue – clean material will be placed in LA3 site.
 - 120 K CY Contaminated, 120 K CY Clean



- Oceanside
 - April dredging - pipeline placement on beach
- Santa Barbara
 - Placement on Beach

Comment: How often dredged?
Response: Two cycles per year

- Ventura Harbor
 - Will use minimal funds to place on beach
 - The Harbor's sandtrap is full of sand
 - Material will go into fed. Nav. Channel if not dredged
 - 150K CY of material to be dredged
- San Diego Harbor P&S being worked on.
 - April advertisement
 - Entrance channel dredging

Comment: CMANC FY13 Budget Update?
Response: \$163 M needed for FY13 – historically receive average of \$60 M per year.

Army Corps, SF District (Tom Kendall / John Dingler)

- Crescent City
 - No update but SPN wants to keep this region as a priority on future (FY12) Coastal RSM Plan efforts
- Eureka – Humboldt Harbor
 - Dredging: Still taking material to HOODS. Negative Declaration with CCC – needs consistency Det.. Develop 5 year plan starting next year.
 - CRSM Plan: 85% Draft Rpt currently being reviewed.
 - EA and CD targeting nearshore placement next year.
- Ocean Beach
 - SF17 new site report will be released for public review through EPA in coming months.
 - SF17 encompasses Ocean Beach Demo Site and contains larger footprint.
 - Ship Channel dredging – material placement at SF8 undesirable due to shoaling concerns.
 - DPR Beach Placement draft completed – ATR to begin soon

Comment: SPN has meeting with Sonoma County. Bodega Bay dredging and placement near Doran Spit discussion has begun. County manages Park and owns it.



- FY12 Dredging: No Navigation POC from SPN available for updates today.

USGS (Jon Warrick)

- Working with Kristin Goodrich to present Communication Plan for Fine Sediment studies – this could be a presentation at next CSMW mtg. Special Session will be held at H2O on this topic as well.
 - Jon will provide time estimate of presentation to Chris for feasibility of a March Presentation.

❖ Updates: State Agencies

Boating and Waterways (Kim Sterrett)

- Section 26 Budget Request
 - SANDAG bids were \$1.7 M over budgeted so DBW is requesting add'l \$750K from Beach Restoration Funds to be applied to SANDAG II.
 - SANDAG can't cover contingency. All other costs are fixed price and can be covered by SANDAG.
 - Add'l \$500K expected from locals so ~\$450K would be needed from other sources but could be neutralized through best sand placement practices.

Comment: Emissions issue?

Response: Dredging wouldn't need retrofit

Comment: Timeline for dredging?

Response: SANDAG will award in next couple weeks and start Construction in April timeframe.

- SF Coastal RSM Plan
 - Clif worked with Athena at ABAG's to reduce the level of effort on the proposed scope from \$90K to \$50K
- BEACON proposal rec'd for RSM Authorization
 - Script will be sent to group for future comment.

Coastal Commission (Mark Johnsson)

- Humboldt Bay Dredging CD being reviewed. Want to split up into immediate plans and future four year efforts for review assessment purposes.

Response: No update, not moving forward.

 - Coastal LIDAR available on NOAA Digital Coast

- Coastal Commission received funds for GIS Staff (Greg Benoit at CCC and others) to update the existing 2005 Coastal Armoring GIS database to answer key management questions for users.
- Scott Gregory (State Geographic Information Officer) – working to set up Statewide Database and associated geoportal. OPC interested in getting an Ocean Tab that will have Coastal and Ocean specific data.
